From the desk of Bishop Bryan:

Now that the full report of the "Commission on a Way Forward" has been released to the public, I am looking forward to discussing it with laity and clergy at our Northeast District meeting on Monday, August 20th, at Pittman Park UMC, Statesboro, Georgia.

In preparation for the meeting please read the report describing the three plans being offered for consideration as a Way Forward for the United Methodist Church. In addition, I invite all South Georgia clergy and laity to join me in the worldwide prayer movement for the General Conference and I ask for daily prayers from 2:23 to 2:26 as delegates prepare for General Conference 2019.

FORMAT: The meetings will begin with a time of spiritual reflection and centering. A video will then highlight the specifics of each of the three proposed plans, taking them in the order listed in the report of the "Commission on a Way Forward." This will be followed by a question and answer time, moderated by Rev. Chris Ramsey, during which I will lead those present in a discussion of the implications of each plan. I will then offer ways the South Georgia Conference might helpfully respond to each of the three plans. The meeting will conclude with a time of prayer.
