More information about the details and specific protocols will be in upcoming bulletins and on our Facebook page, but we have set the date of June 21—Fathers Day as the day we get back in our sanctuary! I am excited about this and I know everyone is looking forward to getting back together.

IN THE MEANTIME....while our 11:00 Online / Radio worship will continue, our 9:00 worship will be modified to include "Lawn Church". In the courtyard, in the covered walkway and in the morning shade of the Social Hall, we will also meet outside. **Bring your own lawn chairs / blankets** and with families together but otherwise keeping this thing we call "social distance", we will meet and worship and sing and praise God!
